Lunches

Children in all year groups should bring a break time snack and a packed lunch to school— hot dinners will not be served during the first half term. You can still contact AIP and request lunches for the week. Children will eat in their classrooms before spending time outside on the playground.

After school clubs & music lessons

All school clubs and music lessons will be postponed until after the first half term, with a view to commencing again after October half term.

PE kits & swimming lessons

Other key information

- ⇒ Astwood Smiles will be open and can be contacted about before and after school care
- ⇒ We ask that children do not bring rucksacks or book bags to school
- ⇒ We shall provide all children with stationery but children in KS2 will require a pencil case of their own so they can keep all equipment in one place
- ⇒ Home learning will not be updated over the summer period, yet existing resources on class pages will remain available until the new academic year
- ⇒ Forest School will take place on Thursday mornings for Reception / Thursday afternoons for Year 1.

What to do in the event of illness

If your child has symptoms of COVID-19 they must stay at home. A test should be then be arranged. The whole household must self-isolate during this time. If the test is negative everyone can return to normal. If your child tests positive they must stay at home for 7 days. Everyone else in the household must isolate for 14 days. NHS Test and Trace will be notified and the school will consult with Public Health England who will look at our records of close contacts and advise who else may need to isolate.
