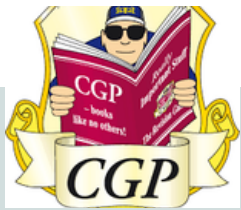

We have had an amazing start to our school year and we are pleased with the confident and enthusiastic approach of the children. We will be letting you know all about year three over the next couple of weeks but here is some important information to begin with.
